#### I. RATIONALE:

Good oral health is part of general health, overall well-being. It contributes to a healthy, productive life and is integral to the unalienable human right to health. The Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) plays high importance on "ensuring healthy lives and promoting well-being for all at all life stages" (SDG 3), including Universal Health Coverage.

The Department of Health (DOH) Oral Health Program's vision is that all people in the Philippines, especially children and other vulnerable groups, enjoy the highest attainable state of oral health, free from oral diseases, enabling everyone to live healthy and productive lives. The "F1 plus" with four pillars namely: Service delivery, Health regulation, Health care financing and Governance system.

Filipinos bear the burden of gum diseases early in their childhood. According to NOHS, 74% of twelve-year-old children suffer from gingivitis. If not treated early, these children become susceptible to irreversible periodontal disease as they enter adolescence and approach adulthood.

In general, tooth decay and gum diseases do not directly cause disability or death. However, these conditions can weaken bodily defenses and serve as portals of entry to other more serious and potentially dangerous systemic diseases and infections. Aside from physical deformity, these two oral diseases may also cause disturbance of speech significant enough to affect work performance, nutrition, social interactions, income, and self-esteem.

In line with this, the Department of Health Center for Health Development I will be conducting Regionwide Oral Health Month on February 22, 2018 (Venue to be determined).

- To raise awareness on the importance of Oral Health Care in all life stages
- To strengthen advocacy on the proper tooth brushing techniques
- To advocate the Oral Program in the Region
