

## CALL FOR TEACHERS AND HOST SCHOOLS FOR THE 2019 KOREA-PHILIPPINES TEACHER EXCHANGE PROGRAMME (KPTEP)

- 1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 071, s. 2019, this office through the Human Resource Development Section, calls for interested applicants of the Korea-Philippines Teacher Exchange Program (KPTEP).
- 2. The Asia-Pacific Teacher-Exchange for Global Education and on the basis of the Cultural Agreement between the Republic of the Philippines and the Republic of Korea, the Korea Philippines Teacher Exchange Program (KPTEP) shall select fourteen (14) teachers who will be joining this year's teacher exchange program to be deployed in selected Korean schools from April 2, 2019 to June 28, 2019 (89 days) as well as seven (7) host schools. On the other hand, fourteen (14) Korean Teachers shall be deployed in the Philippines from August 12 to November 29, 2019 (109) days.
- 3. The duties of the teachers include:
  - Designing and conducting lessons on intellectual understanding and curriculum related to the subjects in collaboration with their mentor teachers;
  - Introducing Filipino-Culture to Korean students and teachers;
  - c. Conducting individual projects to intercultural teaching; and,
  - d. Undertaking other activities to enhance mutual understanding between Korea and the Philippines.
- 4. The host schools shall:
  - a. Ensure safety of exchange teachers during their stay;
  - b. Arrange accommodation for exchange teachers;
  - c. Provide classes to observe/assist/teach for 6 hours minimum each day;
  - d. Provide feedback on exchange teachers' educational activities; and,
  - e. Strengthen the atmosphere of hospitality and tolerance to cultural difference.
- 5. As a general requirement, teacher-applicants must have at least three (3) years minimum teaching experience, over ten (10) years teaching term left and has not been a recipient of any Korean program funding. Other means of verification for teacher-applicants are the following:
  - a. Educational Attainment
  - Innovations and Implemented Programs in the School/District/Division/Regional/National
  - c. Seminars, Workshops and Trainings
