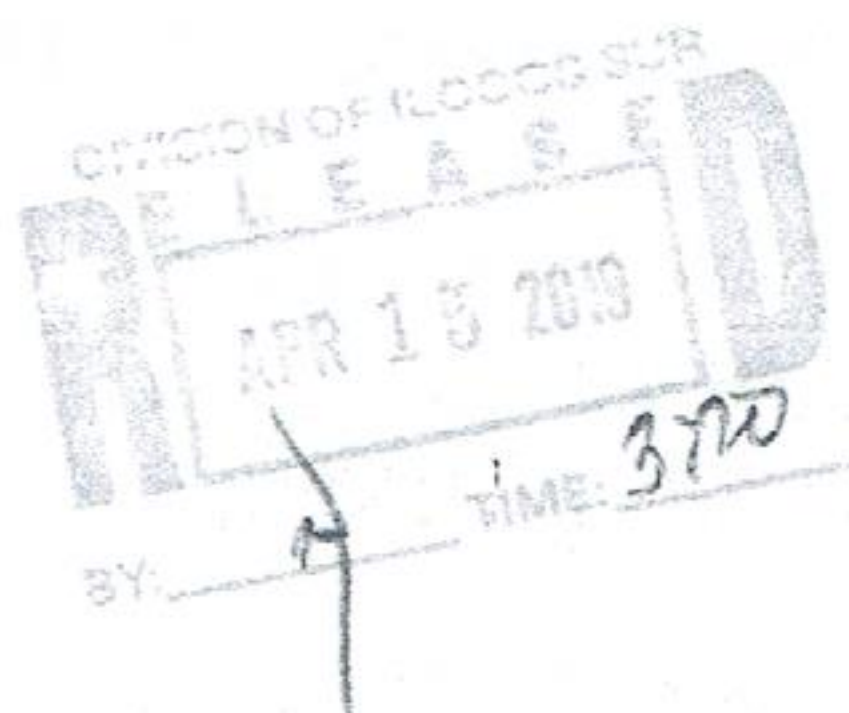

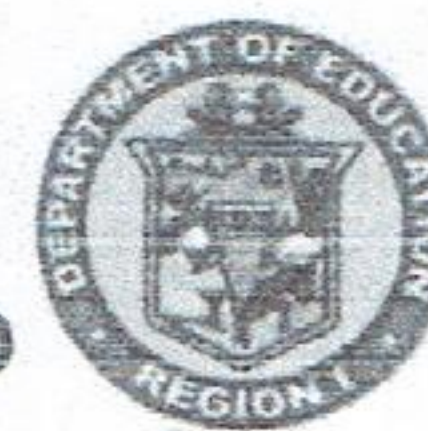

CALL FOR NOMINATION

1. TITLE: OKI Kabataan Awards 2019

OKI Kabataan Awards, also known as Outstanding Kabataan Awards, aim to provide recognition for outstanding youth and student organizations in Ilocos Region who firmly serve our kakailians in different categories such as human rights, environment, education rights, good governance, culture and sports, disaster risk reduction management, promoting peace and battling disinformation and fake news.

2. OBJECTIVES:

Objectives of the award is to acknowledge the youth and student organizations in Ilocos Region who contributed in raising awareness and in providing solutions on different social issues of our society as well as in promoting nationalism through serving our kakailians.

3. MECHANICS on How to Join the OKI Kabataan Awards 2019

A. The awards is open to all youth organizations whose program/project/activity promotes nationalism in serving our kakailians.

B. The contest has seven (7) categories namely:

a. Stewards of the Environment Award

Award for the outstanding youth organization for defending the environment from the destructive acts/projects and for promoting preservation and conservation of our nature.

b. Free Education Movers Award

Award for the outstanding youth organization that promotes the right for free, quality and accessible education for all.

c. Defenders of Human Rights Award

Award for the outstanding youth organization for upholding and defending human rights.

d. Peace Builders Award

Award for the most outstanding youth and student organization for its effort to promote justice and peace.

e. Heritage Advocates Award

Award for the outstanding youth organization that promotes and preserve cultural heritage as well as the advancement of sports

f. Lingkod Bayan Award

Award for the outstanding youth and students organization for its effort in promoting good governance.

g. Disaster Ready Award

Award for the outstanding youth organization that advances Disaster Risk Reduction and Management.

h. Truth Seeker Award

Award for the outstanding youth and students organization for its effort in battling disinformation and proliferation of fake news.

C. All entries must be submitted from April 10-17, 2019 not later than 11:00 pm during the last day of submission. Any entries that will be submitted later than 11:00pm will not be accepted. Submit all required documents/requirements at youthactnowilocos@gmail.com with a subject: OKI Kabataan [insert category] [insert project proponent]. For example: OKI Kabataan stewards of the environment – University Student Council.



D. The youth organizations should submit a copy of their accomplished "nomination form" together with at least three (3) pictures of the documented program/project/activity. Youth organizations should only submit one (1) entry per category.

E. All accepted entries will be posted online at "Kabataan Partylist-Ilocos" Votes are garnered through the following: a. Liking the uploaded album; b. Sharing it (Like = 1 Vote and Share = 2 Votes); and c. Votes of the Board of Judges

F. Online voting will run from April 18-May 4, 2019 not later than 4:00pm. Any votes online that will be casted later than 4:00pm will not be counted as valid votes. So better spread the your submission for more likes and shares/

G. The Board of Judges shall have the discretion not to award any prize if, in its judgment, no meritorious entry has been submitted.

H. The respective speakers of the Ilocos Youth Covenant will be the Board of Judges for all of the categories. The decision of the majority of the Board of Judges in all categories shall be final.

I. Top two on each of the categories will be declared will received the awards.

J. The names of the youth organization winners will be announced during the Ilocos Youth Covenant Cultural Night and Awarding Ceremony.
