



METHODOLOGY

The Dalaw Turo (DT) is a presentation or acting exercises excerpted from an environmental book portraying the characters from the story which focuses on nurturing and caring for the environment. Primary schoolers are more attentive if the presenters deliver their environmental teaching through stage acting or "Salin-Turo" system. A question and answer portion and environmental games, to encourage involvement among the participants. Other activities included will be poster making contest and public speaking contest based on the 2019 Environment Month theme "Beat Air Pollution". The following day a monitoring or technical visit on the environmental projects like "gulayan-sa paaralan, Planting, Growing and Caring for Trees, Waste Management Program, Plastic Free Environment" and other related environment-friendly activities in the schools will also be conducted.

EVALUATION

After the event in each school, a post-test evaluation paper will be given to each participant to answer in order for them to assess the quality of the lecture and other activities imparted to them.

FACILITATORS/LEARNING SERVICE PROVIDER

Learning service providers will come from the DENR Region I and DepEd.

Facilitators will come from EMB, MGB, Regional Public Affairs Office (RPAO) and selected Information Officers from PENROs and CENROs and Sectoral Focal Persons.

BUDGETARY REQUIREMENTS:

The estimated activity cost will only cater one (1) snacks per school with 50-30 pax per school, depends on the request from the school
