



The Department of Agriculture through the Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources Region 1 will be conducting the Fisheries Scholarship Program-Nationwide Recruitment Examination for Industry Leaders (IL) (exclusively among the top ten of the Senior High School graduating class) and the Fisherfolk Children Educational Grant (FCEG) for Senior High school graduating students whose parents are registered fisherfolk in their city/municipality). The Competitive Scholarship examination is for honor graduate students and children of small-scale registered fisherfolk who are interested to pursue a four-year BS Fisheries Course starting 1st Semester of SY 2020-2024 (August 2020). The top examinees among the IL shall also be required to pass the entrance examination and enroll in any of the following State Universities and Colleges (SUCs): Central Luzon State University (CLSU)-Muñoz, Nueva Ecija; University of the Philippines Visayas (UPV)-Miagao, Iloilo; Cagayan State University (CSU)-Aparri, Cagayan, for admission. On the other hand, the top examinees among the FCEG are required to pass the entrance examination and enroll in any of the following SUCs: Pangasinan State University-Binmaley Campus (PSU-BC), Binmaley, Pangasinan; Don Mariano Marcos Memorial State University-College of Fisheries (DMMMSU-CF), Ubagan, Sto. Tomas, La Union; Ilocos Sur Polytechnic State College-Narvacan Campus (ISPSC-NC), Narvacan, Ilocos Sur and Mariano Marcos State University (MMSU), Pias Sur, Currimao, Ilocos Norte.

Relative to this, may we request from your good office for assistance in the dissemination of the information for wider coverage. Attached herewith is the application form with the criteria for eligibility and checklist of documentary requirements. All qualified applicants should file their application with complete documentary requirements on or before October 30, 2019at BFAR-Regional Office-1.



- 7. Parent(s)/guardian or the applicant must be physically residing in the municipality of the Region for at least six (6) months, where the slot of the scholarship program is allotted;
- 8. Parent(s)/guardian must be registered municipal fisherfolk duly certified by the Municipal Agricultural Officer (MAO) or the BFAR regional office in his/her area.
