- 1. Pursuant to the implementation of DepEd Order No. 32, s. 2017 re: Gender-Responsive Basic Education Policy, the Schools Division of Ilocos Sur will conduct a Two-day Seminar-Workshop on Integrating GAD in the Curriculum through Gender-Responsive Lesson Exemplars on July 25-26, 2019 at Hotelinda Suites, Vigan City, llocos Sur.




