**Subject: CALL FOR CLIMATE ACTION ON 20-27 SEPTEMBER 2019**

Moved by the climate realities faced by the Philippines and inspired by the global youth action, young Filipinos nationwide will take part in the Global Climate Strike, a movement of young people to call for governments and private sector in prioritizing climate justice, on 20-27 September 2019.

With this, the Department enjoins school heads and teachers to excuse students who will be joining the localized climate strike provided that parental/legal guardian consent is given. Likewise, the Department encourages schools and offices to conduct climate education and action activities within school grounds. Examples may include noise barrage, school or community clean-up, and educational discussions. School Student Government (SSG) and Youth for Environment in Schools Organization (YES-O) student leaders are encouraged to lead the activities. Safety and security of learners should be of utmost priority.

Participating schools and offices may post their activities on social media especially Workplace using the hashtag, #DepEdClimateAction. Schools are encouraged to submit a maximum of one-minute video documentation of their activities to [drmo+nccc@deped.gov.ph](mailto:drmo+nccc@deped.gov.ph). Selected activities may be featured at the 3rd National Climate Change Conference on 18 November 2019 in Metro Manila.
