September is National Ozone Protection Month and the La Union LINK Riders in partnership with the Lupon ng mga Indibidwal na Nangangalagang Kalikasan (LINK) will be conducting RIDE FOR CHANGE V3. This is a motorcycle challenge to complete a 270-kilometer circuit within the whole Province of La Union. In line with its environmental advocacy, various challenges will also be conducted in selected localities within the Province of La Union on September 29, 2019.

The Ride will start and end at the City Hall of San Fernando, La Union. From this point, riders will go southeast, head to Naguilian via the Naguilian Road, then to Burgos. From Burgos, they will head to Caba, then will proceed to Rosario then turn left going to Pugo. From Pugo, they will head to San Juan via the Diversion Road take a right to Santol via San Gabriel. They will head for Balaoan via the Mc Arthur Highway, then proceed to Sudipen via Bangar. From Sudipen, they will head to Bacnotan via the coastal route then head back to the San Fernando Finish Line.

The eco-challenges will be held in the following municipalities with the respective challenges:

1. Naguilian-Treasure Hunt;
2. Pugo-Push Race;
3. Bauang-Clean Beach-ness;
4. Santol-Plant A Tree;
5. Bacnotan- Green Quiz Challenge.

As there have been increases in rider groups in the Province as well as a growing number of motorcycle enthusiasts, the event is open to all motorcycle makes and models with open categories and open engine displacement. Below are the categories:

1. INDIVIDUAL – 1 rider

2. TANDEM – 2 rider team
3. COUPLE – 1 motorcycle with pillion (official back ride)
4. TEAM – 5 rider team

A Ride for Change is open to all motorcycle enthusiasts who meet the motorcycle and registration requirements. Upon registration, riders will be given an event shirt and stickers, vest and winners will be awarded prizes. Finishers will be given a Certificate of Finish.

The Ride is specifically designed for motorcycle groups to be more acquainted with the scenery and back roads of the Province in line with the Provincial Government's Vision to make La Union the Heart of Agri-Tourism of Northern Luzon by 2025.

In this regard, we are inviting your agency to register interested employees to this event. For every ten (10) registrants, the agency is entitled to one free rider. Please find attached documents for registration details. We hope you can join this annual event as we work towards environmental action, conservation, and education as well as motorcycle and road safety.

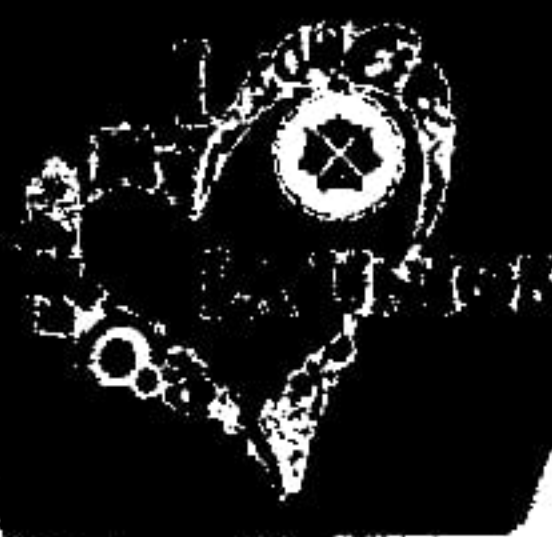

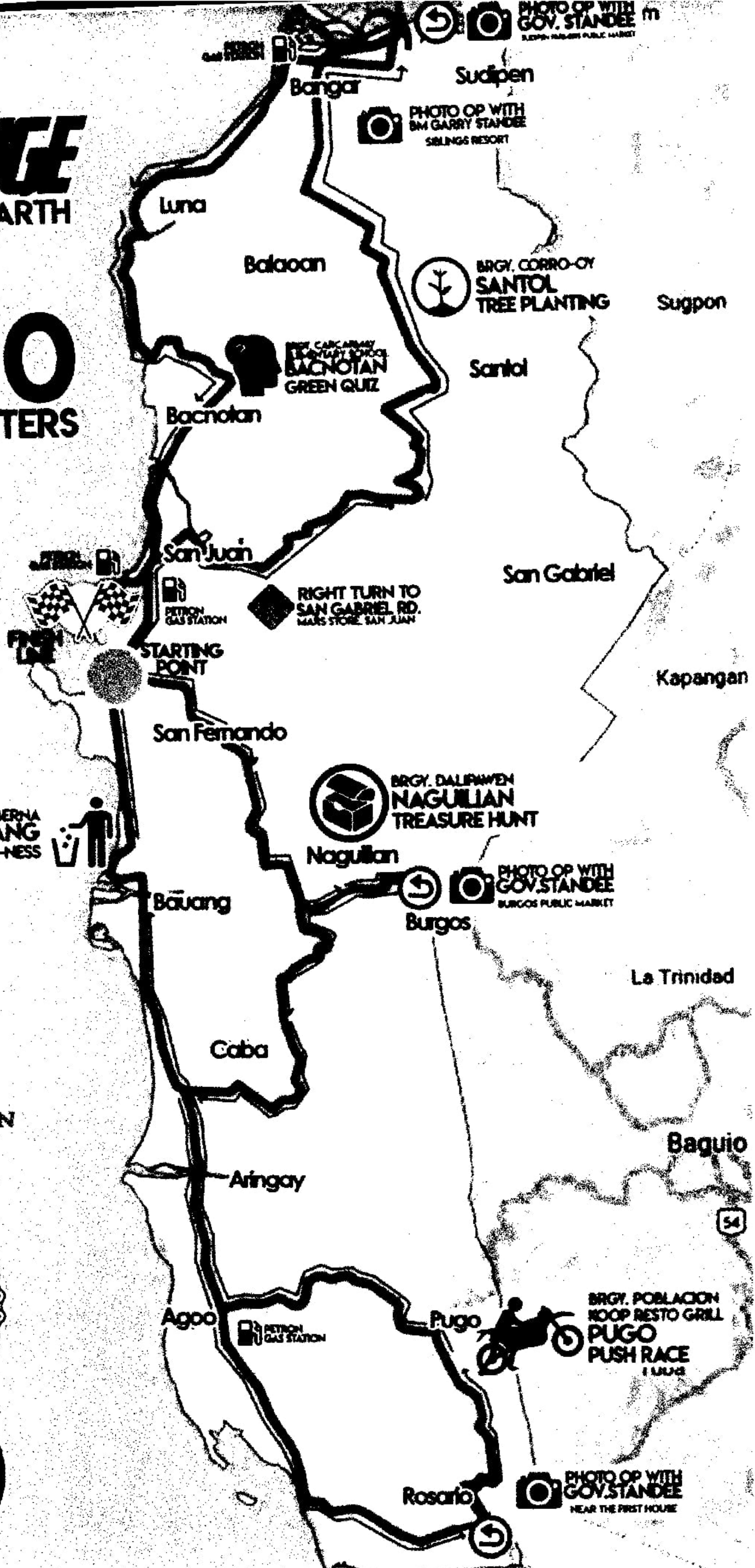

1. BACKGROUND



September is National Ozone Protection Month and the La Union Link Riders in partnership with Lupon ng mga Indibidwal na Nangangalaga ng Kalikasan (LINK) will be conducting A RIDE FOR CHANGE. This is a motorcycle challenge to complete a 270-kilometer circuit within the province of La Union. In line with its environmental advocacy, various challenges featuring eco-friendly activities will also be conducted in the selected localities within the Province during the course of the event.

2. REQUIREMENTS

- All motorcycle displacement is allowed to participate.
- Rider must own a motorcycle with updated Registration.
- Driver's License with Restriction J.
- Riders must be in complete safety gear.
- Complete registration form and waiver must be submitted to the organizer. NO WAIVER NO RIDE.
- Mobile phone with camera

3. CATEGORIES & CLASS

Participants will be classified according to the engine displacement of their motorcycle as follows:

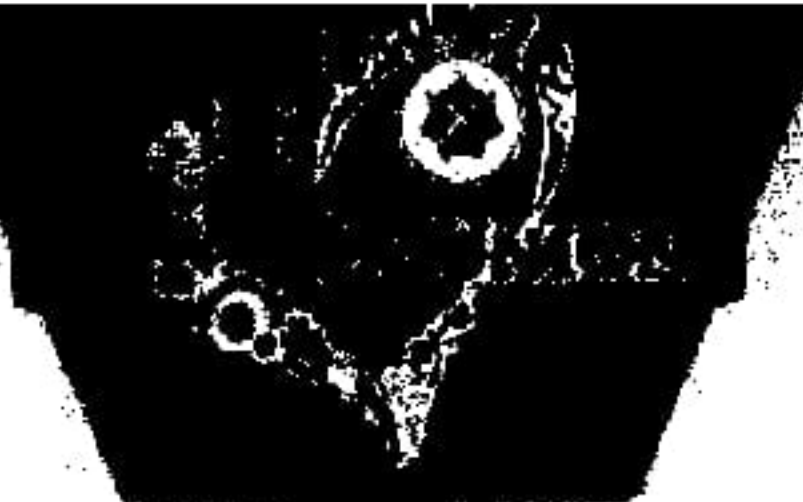
- Class 1 (0 to 125 cc)
- Class 2 (126 to 155 cc)
- Class 3 (156 to 250 cc)
- Class 4 (251 and up)
- Individual / Solo
- Couple / Pillion
- Tandem / Buddy
- Group – comprised of five (5) riders

Note: for Tandem and Group of Five, motorcycle must have the same displacement

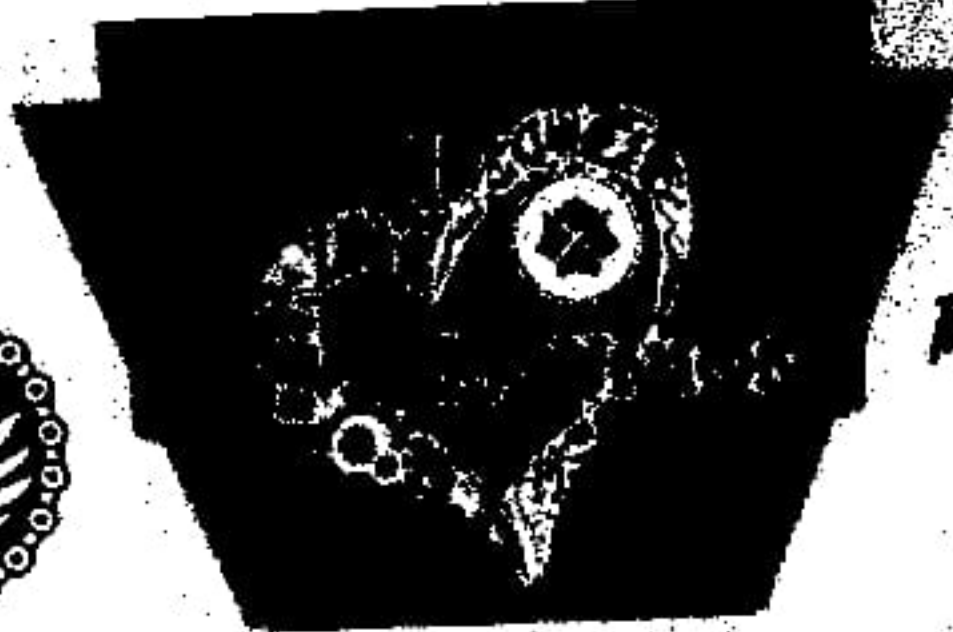

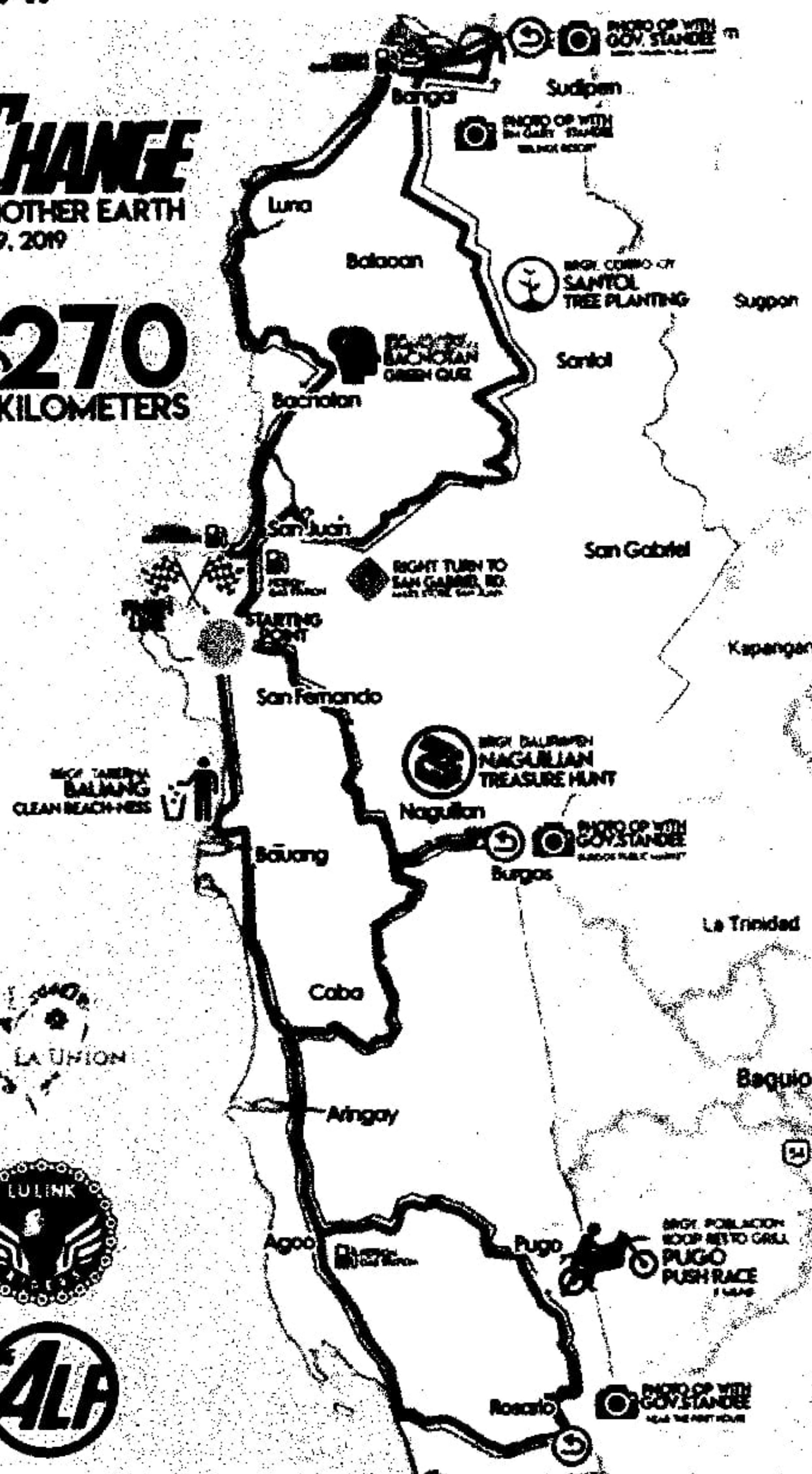
7. ROUTE MAP

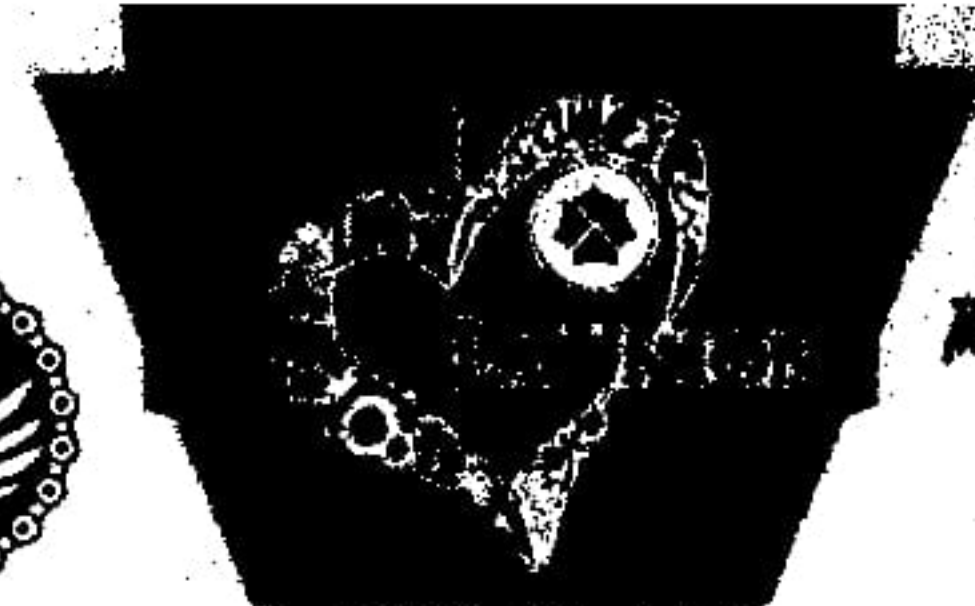

8. GENERAL RULES

- PRE RIDERS INSPECTION (PRI) will be start 9:00pm. to 3:00am. of September 29, 2019
- Gun start shall be exactly 6:00am September 29, 2019 with riders leaving individually or in group (lowest to highest per class) at 10 second intervals.
- All gas tanks will be SEALED BEFORE EVENT START
- REFUELING of tanks at the DESIGNATED GAS PETRON stations only (AGOO, SAN JUAN and BANGAR)
- Gasoline Tanks will be topped-off and riders are REQUIRED to FULL TANK at the DESIGNATED Finish Line.

A. SCORING SYSTEM

The riders TOTAL TIME by passing through all the prescribed routes and riders GAS CONSUMPTION PER LITER will be computed by adding Total Time & Total Quantity of Gas Loaded. Take note that 1 liter per consumption is equivalent to 20 minutes.

Example 1 Computation:

Total Time -----	2hrs & 30mins	= 150
Total Quantity of Gas Loaded -----	5 liters	= 100
Total Score -----		<u>250</u>

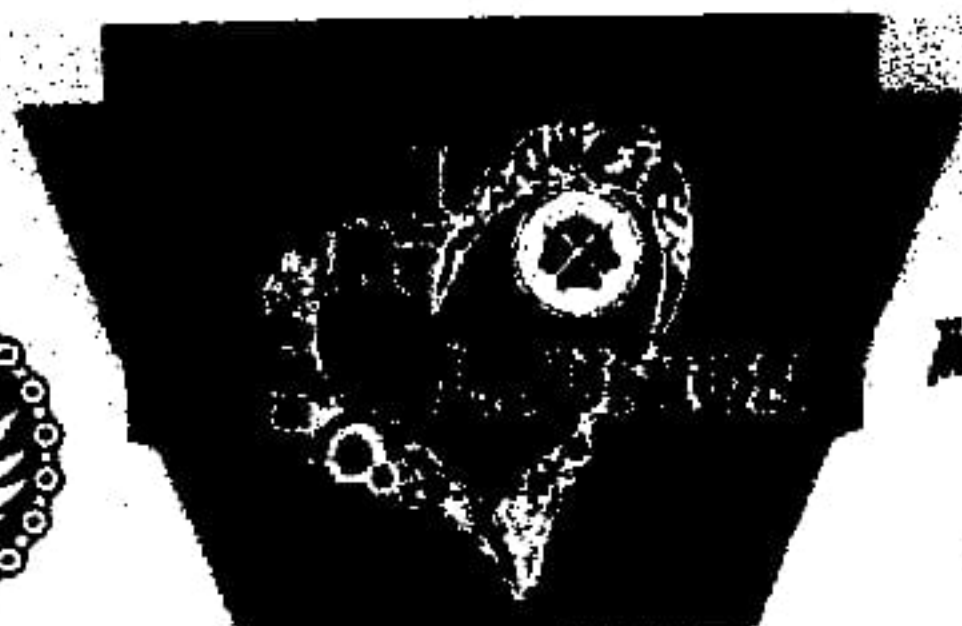
Example 2 Computation:

Total Time -----	2hrs & 15mins	= 135
Total Quantity of Gas Loaded -----	4.5 liters	= 90
Total Score -----		<u>225</u>

The participants with the lowest total score after all the deductions will be declared the winner in each class and categories.

B. REFUELING PROCEDURES

- Riders are required only to gas up at Authorized Gas Petron Stations along the way. Organizers will seal the gas tank lids every time a rider loads gas.
- Organizer will replace the seal on the gas tank lids with their coded seals. Riders and Organizers will be responsible to check the accuracy of the gasoline quantity loaded and securing an official Receipt (OR) before leaving. Gasoline OR will be required to be presented at the Finish Line.
- Refueling will be on a first come first serve basis. Upon dismounting from his/her motorcycle, the rider must present his/her passport to the organizers for verification.
- Riders should have their tanks full at the Finish Line to compute the gasoline consumption of each rider. Motorcycles must be on center stand or on an upright position during the top-off.

9. PRIZES & AWARDS

- Awards will be given to the 1st – 3rd place finishers by categories
- Certificate of Finish will be awarded to all finishers

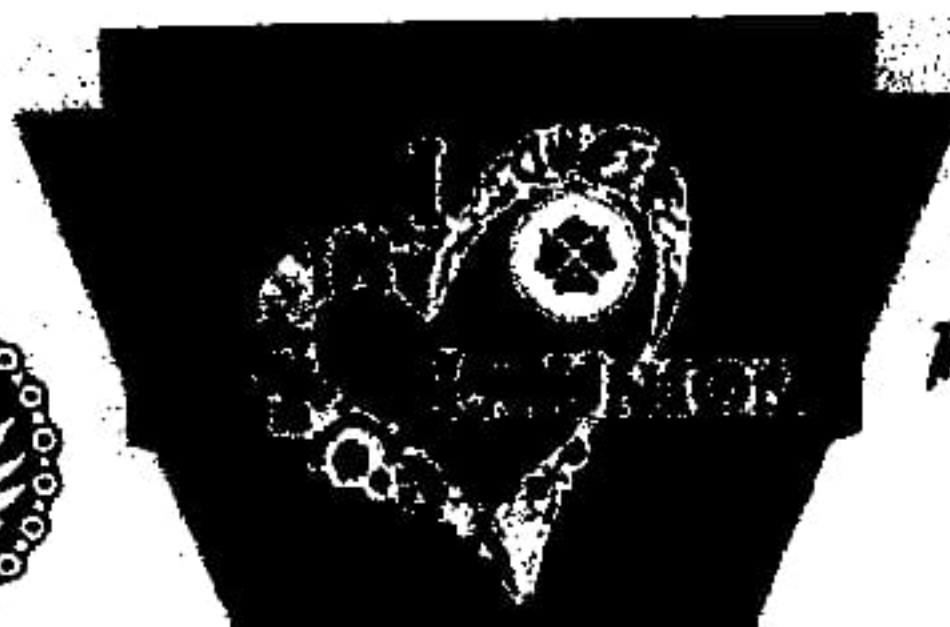
10. RACE MARSHAL & MEDICAL TEAMS

- WHITE ORGANIZERS** are responsible for the event from the start to finish, and make sure that the event will run smoothly.
- YELLOW MARSHAL** shall assist in route directions, safety procedures and ensure responsible driving.
- GREEN MARSHALLS** are in charge of eco-challenges and will fill up passports when challenges are completed.
- MEDICAL TEAM** will be stationed at Naguilan, Caba and Santol shall convoy the last contingent of riders.

11. GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION

- Riders who exceed the prescribed cut off time (8hours)
- Riders who fail to pass the prescribed route and/or miss an eco-challenge
- Boarding a bike on a moving vehicle
- Pushed manually by another rider by foot or on motorcycle
- Riders who damage or tamper fuel tank lid seals.
- Riders who hold onto a moving vehicle and turn off their engine on a downhill
- Failure to observe local road rules and regulations
- Riders who are disorderly, unsafe and do not observe road courtesy
- Bike with open pipes & Auxiliary tanks

ROVING MARSHALLS are authorized to disqualify riders who violate the event rules and regulations.

12. COMPLAINTS & PROTESTS

- All complaints and/or protest regarding the event must be presented to the organizers in writing within 24-hours after the event.
