Dear Dr. Reinante:

Republic Act No. 11036 otherwise known as Mental Health Law (June 20, 2018) stipulates in Sec. 2 that the state affirms basic right of all Filipinos to mental health as well as the fundamental rights of people who require mental health services. In this regard, Sec. 23 promotes the integration of mental health into the educational system such that the state shall ensure the integration of mental health into the educational system -age- appropriate content pertaining to mental health shall be integrated into the curriculum at all educational levels.

Further, Sec. 24 states that educational institutions such as schools, colleges, universities and technical schools shall develop policies and programs for students, educators and other employees designed to: raise awareness on mental health issues, identify and provide support and services for individuals at risk, and facilitate access, including referral mechanisms of individuals with mental health conditions to treatment and psychosocial support. All public and private institutions shall be required to have a complement of mental health professionals.

In this regard, the proposed seminar-workshop will allow teachers, counselors and school staff to be aware of their inherent responsibilities in promoting mental health as the primary carers of the holistic development of the students. Given the increasing number of mental health concerns of students nowadays, teachers, counsellors, homeroom advisers and school staff are being tapped in assisting the students in addressing their mental health concerns nonetheless of the insufficient number of trained professionals as well as limited capacities of handling these concerns. The topics shall discuss the context of mental health in schools, roles of teachers in the promotion and the latest trends in handling students' mental health issues in the local and foreign settings.
