


TO: Public Elementary School Heads

Attached are the letter from the Officer-In-Charge, Boy Scouts of the Philippines, Ilocos Sur Council, Vigan City, Ilocos Sur dated September 30, 2019 and Regional Office Memorandum No. 14, s. 2019 regarding the conduct of the 1<sup>st</sup> Ilocos Region Kab-O-Ree to be held at Pangasinan Provincial Nursery, Tebag, Sta. Barbara, Pangasinan on October 23-26, 2019, for information.

Relative to the conduct of the above-mentioned activity, this Office reminds the following provisions:

- Parents permit shall be sought and precautionary measures shall be instituted to ensure the lives and safety of all concerned. Any action therefore should be the discretion and responsibility of the school head. However, it is the school's moral and legal obligation to look after the welfare of the participants, hence, extraordinary diligence shall be exercised at all times;
- 2. Participation to this activity is voluntary;
- 3. Administrative remedies shall be undertaken to the classes left behind by the teacher-participants;
- 4. Attendance to this activity shall be on Official Time only; and
- 5. The implementation of "No Collection Policy" pursuant to the implementing rules and regulations of DepEd Order No. 41, s. 2012, DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017 re: Implementing Guidelines on the Conduct of Off-Campus Activities and DepEd No. 9, s. 2005 re: Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-On-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith shall be strictly observed.





1. We are pleased to announce the holding of the First Ilocos Regional KAB-O-Ree on 23-26 October 2019 at Pangasinan Provincial Nursery, Tebag, Sta. Barbara. Pangasinan.

# 2. Aims & Objectives.

The KAB-O-Ree aims to provide an environment of learning, safe and enjoyable to enhance their physical, social, mental, emotional and spiritual potentials. By the end of the jamboree the scouts would be able to:

- 2.a Undergo activities that will enable them to complete requirements for the Growing Usa rank
- 2.b. strengthen the role parents in the KAB Scouting section and enhanced partnerships with the Kawan Leaders and other adult leaders in the unit
- 2.c undertake environmental activities that will promote awareness of their roles as young people towards environment under the Better World Programs
- 2.d Develop skills and capacities through team buildings activities, games, group dynamics, creativity, character building and critical thinking.


#### 3. Qualification:

#### 3.a Scout

- registered KAB Scouts
- must be grade 3 or eight years old and above

#### 3.b Adult Leaders

- registered Unit Leader for at least two years and have adequate camping experience
- physically fit as certified by a physician and of good moral character



#### 3.c Regional Service Team

Each local council shall provide 5 trained Kawan Leaders (preferably Woobadge Holders and Better World Framework participants) to serve as Regional Service Team to handle the different modules for the KAB-O-Ree namely:

Regional Service Teas are expected to be at the KAB-O-Ree site afternoon of 21 October for briefing and coaching.

# 4. Registration Details

# 4.a Registration Fee

A registration fee of Five Hundred Pesos (Php 500.00) shall be charged each participant to defray souvenir items (shirt & bag), administrative costs, program materials, camp development and other operating expenses.

# 4.b Registration Guidelines

In order to provide Pangasinan-San Carlos City Council the much needed logistical and administrative preparation, a reservation fee of Two Hundred Pesos (Php 200.00) shall be submitted to Pangasinan-San Carlos City on or before 7 October which will serve as seed money for the jamboree. This also will determine the strength of the participation and to give ample time for the preparation of program materials, souvenir items and other administrative concern.

Should there be additional registration after the deadline of the payment of registration, they would be treated the least priority on all issuances but can attend the activities/modules of the KAB-O-Ree.

# 4.c Participation Ratio:

A minimum ratio of 1 adult leader in every four boys shall be observed (one shall be a parent who is member of the unit committee). This is to minimize the number of adults in the camp and providing the scouts the opportunity to help in the prepare their own meals and orderliness in the camp. All parents attending shall also pay the corresponding registration.



# 5. Travel Itinerary

All council KAB-O-Ree contingents must be settled in the camp not later than 1000hrs, 23 October 2019 and will only be allowed to leave the camp after the Grand Closing Ceremonies and issuance of Camp Clearance.

All contingents are advised to travel during day time and be very vigilant while traveling.

### 6. Food & other Jamboree Provisions

The Council Contingent shall make sure that the food provision and other basic requirements shall be adequate for the duration of the jamboree. Wet and dry markets will be available in the camp.

- For light & water provisions, all council contingents shall bring their own water containers and wire/extensions. Source or power will only be installed in strategic locations.
- 7. All Council Scout Executives/Officers-In-Charge are enjoined to promote the KAB-O-REE to all districts/schools in their respective councils. They should also be responsible for the official release of their delegation from their respective division.
