
Academic and Literacy Competition

GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA

ACADEMIC COMPETITIONS (Philippine Government, History, Geography, Culture and Current Events, General Information and Ilocano Culture)

1. Question shall be prepared solely by the host School (OSA-UNP)

2. Each school is entitled to three contestants composing a team, who are bona fide students of the school/college/university. (One team for Senior High School and another team for Junior High School)

3. Contestants will answer in writing the same set of questions. Before a question is read, the contestants must raise must raise their right hand. Each team will be provided with an illustration board, chalk and eraser.

4. The question will be read twice by the Quizmaster. It is only after the Quizmaster shall say "go" that the team be allowed to write the answer. The ten (10) second time limit/countdown will begin simultaneously with the word "go" by the Quizmaster. If a question requires enumeration, the time limit will be extended to five (5) more seconds.

5. After the time limit, buzzer will sound; the team should stop writing and raise their right hand.

6. The proctors will go around and check the answer of the teams.

7. The contest has two (2) rounds, Level I and Level II. In level I, fifteen (15) questions will be asked. Each question is worth one (1) point. After asking fifteen questions, the Quizmaster announces the top five (5) teams garnering the highest scores which will advance to level II. If there is a tie for the fifth (5th) place, both will advance to the next level.

8. Ten (10) questions will be asked in the second (2nd) round. This time, two (2) points will be assigned for

each correct answer.

9. After the tenth (10th) question, the three (3) teams getting the highest scores in level I and level II will be declared champion, 1st runner-up and 2nd runner-up. Since there are only three (3) places, should there be a tie, extra questions will be asked by the Quizmaster in order to break the tie.

10. The duly registered teacher-coach of the team is the only person authorized to make a protest. All protest should be referred to the board of judges immediately before the Quizmaster reads the next question.

- 6. Ang hatol ng inampalan ay pinal.

Extemporaneous Speech

- 1. The topic shall be given on the spot by the judges.
 - The judges shall give the common topic prior to the start of the competition related to current events whether local, national or international.

 - There shall be three (3) rooms (i.e. waiting, preparation and delivery).

 - The undertime, overtime deductions apply.
 - A timer accessible to the contestant, judges and audience shall be provided.
 - The contest master is accountable to the sanctity of the competition.
 - There will be point deduction of 1 point for every 10 seconds undertime or overtime from the respective judge's total score before determining the rank of the contestants.
- 3. The style of the delivery shall be conversational, oratorical or combination of both.
 - Dramatic Style is considered a disqualification.
- 4. The contestant should wear his/her school uniform.
- 5. Use of sound effects, microphones and props are not allowed.
- 6. After the deliberation of the members of the board of judges, the judges' decision is final.
