PROVINCIAL QUIZ BEE CONSUMER WELFARE MONTH OCTOBER 24, 2019

THEME: "SUSTAINABLE CONSUMPTION: UNDERSTANDING THE IMPACT OF CONSUMER'S CHOICE IN A SHARED ENVIRONMENT"

MECHANICS:

I. Qualifications:

- A team of High School (Junior) students composed of three (3) students
 per team currently enrolled in any SECONDARY School in the province
 during the current term may join the contest. For public high schools, the
 team shall be endorsed by the Schools Division Superintendent while for
 private high schools; the team shall be endorsed by their School Principal.
- Should there be any substitution, their names shall be submitted to DTIllocos Sur two days before the contest. Student participants are required to present their IDs prior to the contest.
- The team allocation shall be as follows:

- Ilocos Sur Division

- 4 teams

- Vigan City Division

- 2 teams

- Candon City Division

- 2 teams

- Private High Schools

- 1 team each

- The Quiz Bee proper shall be held at the Hotelinda Suites, Vigan City, llocos Sur on October 24, 2019 (Thursday) at 8:00 A.M.
- Deadline for submission of entries will be on October 21, 2019 (Monday)
 at the DTI-llocos Sur Provincial Office, Judy Chiu Bldg., Mabini St., Vigan
 City

II. Rules:

- The contest is divided into three (3) parts. Each part shall consist of 10 questions, with a 5-minutes break at the end of Part I.
- The questions are classified as Easy, Moderate and Difficult worth 10, 20 and 30 points respectively.

ILOCOS SUR PROVINCIAL OFFICE Certified ISO 9001:2015 Participants shall be given a definite time frame to answer questions:

Easy – 10 seconds Moderate – 15 seconds Difficult – 20 seconds

- The Quiz Master shall read each question twice specifying the time limit, and point contribution. Timing will start after the second reading.
- Final answers should be legibly written on an illustration board provided.
 Illustration board should be raised after the given time has expired.
- The Quiz Master shall read answers of each participating school regardless if whether the answer is correct or not. No deductions will be given for unanswered questions or wrongly answered questions.
- Answers with wrong spelling shall not be accepted.
- All complaints/protests must be addressed to the Board of Judges right
 after the reading of the correct answer of the question concerned. No
 complaints on a previous question shall be entertained once the quiz
 master starts reading the next question. Only the contestants or their
 coach/adviser can raise a protest.
 - Top three teams with the highest score gathered will be declared champion, first placer and second placer respectively.
 - Should a tie exist, the match shall go into a tie breaker questions. The first team who will get two correct answers will be declared the winner of the tie. In the event that two teams will get two correct answers at the same time, a next tie breaker question will be given to break the tie, and so on and so forth.
