1. The Department of Education, Schools Division of Ilocos Sur will conduct **CONVERGENCE: DIVISION MOTHER TONGUE DAY** at Baggoc Pantay Quitiquit Elementary School, Baggoc, Caoayan, Ilocos Sur on **November 14, 2019**.
  2. The objectives of this festival are as follows:
    - a. Enhance the competencies of teachers and learners in MTB-MLE;
    - b. To promote culture of excellence and competitiveness along MTB-MLE instructions among

  4. Contestants in the division level are 1<sup>st</sup> place winners in every contested event in the district elimination which will be conducted on **November 7, 2019**. Official delegates also include the district supervisors, district coordinators, coaches, school heads, facilitators, judges, committee members and technical working group. Interested private schools may join in the contest.
  5. Final briefing of district coordinators, facilitators and technical working group shall be on **November 12, 2019**. Likewise, registration of contestants per district shall be submitted.
  6. Administrative remedies shall be undertaken to the classes left behind by the teacher-participants.
  7. Expenses incidental to the attendance on the said activity shall be charged against local/ MOOE and other sources of funds available in the school subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulation.
  8. Considering the importance of the festival, public schools district supervisors, public elementary school principals/administrators and all concerned are enjoined to extend full support and cooperation.
  9. Enclosed are the guidelines on the different contested activities, program of activities, board of judges, officiating officials, facilitators and working committees.
10. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum to all concerned is enjoined.

**GUIDELINES OF THE DIFFERENT CONTESTS**  
**CONVERGENCE: DIVISION MOTHER TONGUE DAY**

**Pupil's Category**

**\*Daniw (Kinder)**

**GUIDELINES:**

1. Each contestant should be a Kindergarten pupil.
2. There should be only one contestant per district.
3. There will be a common piece for all the contestants.
4. No props and back drafts are allowed but contestants may wear costumes appropriate to the piece.
5. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
6. Top 5 will be awarded in the division level.

**CRITERIA FOR JUDGING:**

Delivery (Pronunciation, Diction, Voice & Expression)	-	50%
Mastery of the Piece	-	40%
Over-all Impact	-	<u>10%</u>

**\*Kanta – Iloko Song (Grade 1)**

**GUIDELINES:**

1. Contestant should be a Grade 1 pupil.
2. There should be only one contestant per district.
3. Each contestant has the chance to choose any Ilocano Song, in 3-5 minutes.
4. The music to be used should be in minus one. No live accompaniment to be used.
5. All flash drives/DVDs/CDs should be tested before the start of the contest to avoid delay.
6. Contestants must be in proper attire.
7. Official microphone provided by the organizers shall be used.
8. Coaches/trainers should refrain from coaching while the contestant is performing.
9. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
10. Top 5 will be awarded in the division level.

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### **\*Best Parent and Child Reading Partners (Grade 2)**

#### **GUIDELINES:**

1. The competition is open to any Grade 2 pupil with his/her parent.
2. There should be only one contestant per district.
3. The piece will be given 5 minutes to read and practice (actions, blockings, etc.) and 5 minutes to perform, which will be given by the division organizer. In the district elimination, the coordinator shall be responsible in giving the story to be read.
4. The other contestants will stay in a holding area/room where they will practice and wait their turn to perform. They are not allowed to watch their opponents' performances.
5. The contestants have the freedom to choose any strategy or technique in the delivery of the piece.
6. Contestants must be in proper attire.
7. Teacher-parent are not allowed to join in this contest.
8. Coaches/trainers should refrain from coaching while the contestant is performing.
9. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
10. Top 5 will be awarded in the division level.

### **\*Iloko Ortograpiya Spelling (Grade 3)**

#### **GUIDELINES:**

1. The competition is open to any Grade 3 pupil.
2. There should be only one contestant per district.
3. The contestant is expected to follow the rules and regulations of the contested activity.
4. The Division Technical Working Group (TWG) which include the EPS in-charge of MTB-MLE and the board of judges will be responsible in preparing the spelling words. (reference: Tarabay iti Ortograpiya ti Pagsasao nga Ilokano 2012)  
In the district elimination, the coordinator shall be responsible in the spelling word preparation.
5. Each word will be used in a sentence. The Spelling Master will read each sentence twice, then a signal will be given for the contestants to write their answers on a sheet of paper to be provided by the management.
6. The words shall be given points according to point system below:

Type	No. of Items	Points	Total
Easy	10	2	20
Average	10	3	30
Difficult	10	5	50
<b>Grand Total</b>			<b>100</b>





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7. Each contestant shall be given ten (10) seconds to write his/her answer.
8. The contestant who will garner the highest number of points will be declared as winner.
9. In case of tie, the prepared items for clincher will be given.
10. The decision of the board of judges is final and irrevocable.

**Teacher's Category (K to 3)**

**\*Best Instructional Material in Mother Tongue**

**GUIDELINES:**

1. There shall be one contestant per district from any Grade level (K to 3).
2. Presentation and defense shall not exceed 5 minutes.
3. Submit 5 copies of write-ups in A4 size coupon bond with folders.
4. Parts of the write up are unique *Title, Rationale, Introduction, Body, Conclusion, Recommendation* in 3-5 pages
5. Documentation and other evidences of functionality in the classroom will be attached to the write-ups.
6. Bring with them the Instructional Material in Mother Tongue ready for the defense.
7. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

3. The piece will be given 5 minutes to read and practice (actions, blockings, etc.) and 5-10 minutes to perform, which will be given by the division organizer. In the district elimination, the coordinator shall be responsible in giving the story to be read.
4. The other contestants will stay in a holding area/room where they will practice and wait their turn to perform. They are not allowed to watch their opponents' performances.
5. The contestants have the freedom to choose any strategy or technique in the delivery of the piece.
6. Contestants must be in proper attire.
7. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
8. Top 5 will be awarded in the division level.

2. Submit 5 copies of write-ups in A4 size coupon bond with folders.
3. Parts of the write-up in the Best Reading Program in Mother Tongue are *Unique Title, Rationale, Introduction, Body (Significance, Time Frame, Impact), Conclusion, Recommendation*.
4. Photos and other important supporting documents are included in the write-ups to be submitted.
5. Judges will judge the write-ups submitted. No need for defense.
6. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
7. Top 5 will be awarded in the division level. All other entries will be given a Certificate of Recognition as Division Qualifier.
