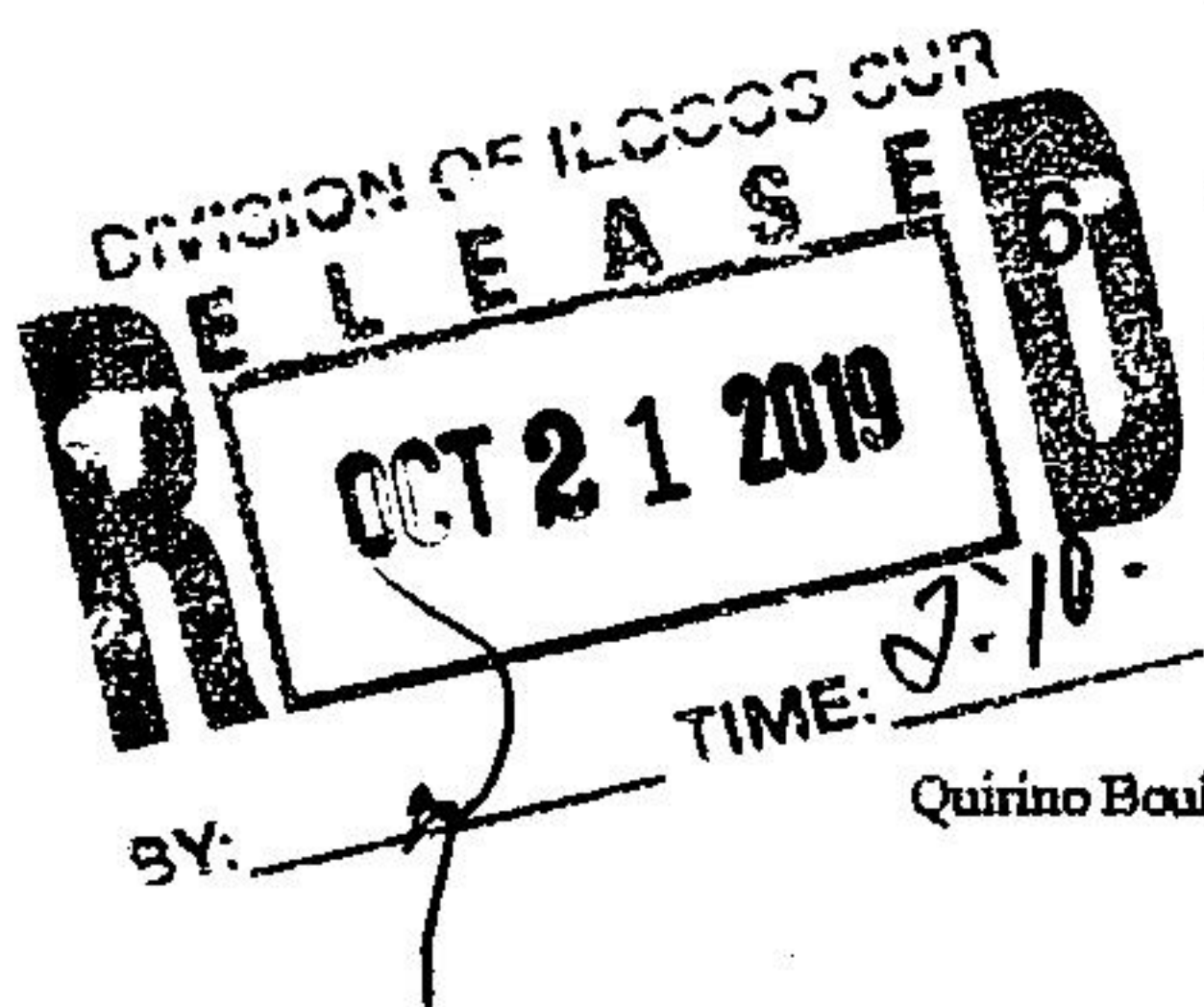

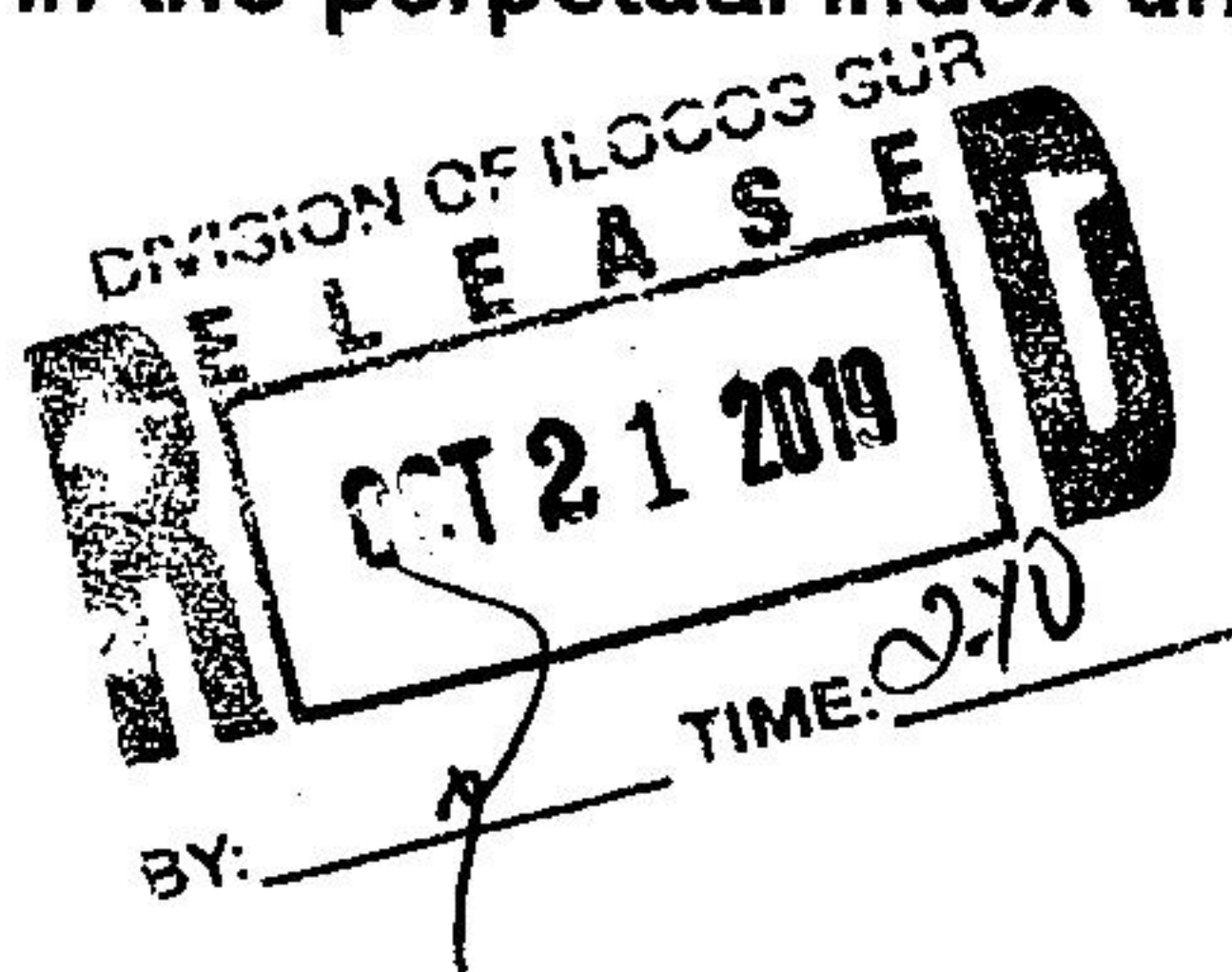

**Additional Information for Araling Panlipunan
Contested Activities (Elementary Level)**

The theme for this festival is : "Kulturang Pilipino Aking Isusulong Upang Manatili sa Puso't Isipan Ko"

Contested activities and the criteria for judging are the following :

a. Solong pag-awit ng Makabayan song (no remix) with accompaniment of recorded piano organ/ minus one (Grades III or IV)

Voice Quality - 50%

Timing - 30%

Stage Present - 20%

b. Kamalaysayan Quiz Show which include current events in the average and difficult questions ((Grade Grade IV –VI)

Team shall composed of one(1) regular Learner and one(1) with Disability. Test questions shall be based on Araling Panlipunan Grades 4-6 competencies. Each team will bring white board, marker and eraser. Questions are divided into: (6) easy,(7) average,(7) difficult

Easy question- 10 items @ 1 point each correct answer

Average - 10 items @ 2 points each correct answer

Difficult - 10 items @ 3 points each correct answer

c. Oration (in Filipino Language) maximum of 3 minutes delivery (Grade VI)

Contents and relevance to the theme - 50%

Delivery (proper diction & pronunciation)- 40%

Stage presence/overall impact - 10%

Contested Activities (Secondary Level)

Each entry will have a contribution of P100 to defray expenses for the medals, meals and snacks of the Board of Judges and other guests, decorations and other incidental expenses

The following contest categories: PopDev Debate, Pop Quiz Show, Jingle Writing and Singing, Poster-Making for Secondary and Senior High School Level.

All contested activities shall be based on the following Population Education Core Messages/Key Concept.

- Family Life and Responsible Parenthood
- Gender and Development
- Population, Environment, Resources and Sustainable Development
- Population and Reproductive Health

Illustration board (1/4 size) and oil pastel crayon will be used for the Poster-Making which will be shouldered by the participant.

Theme shall be announced on-the-spot.
