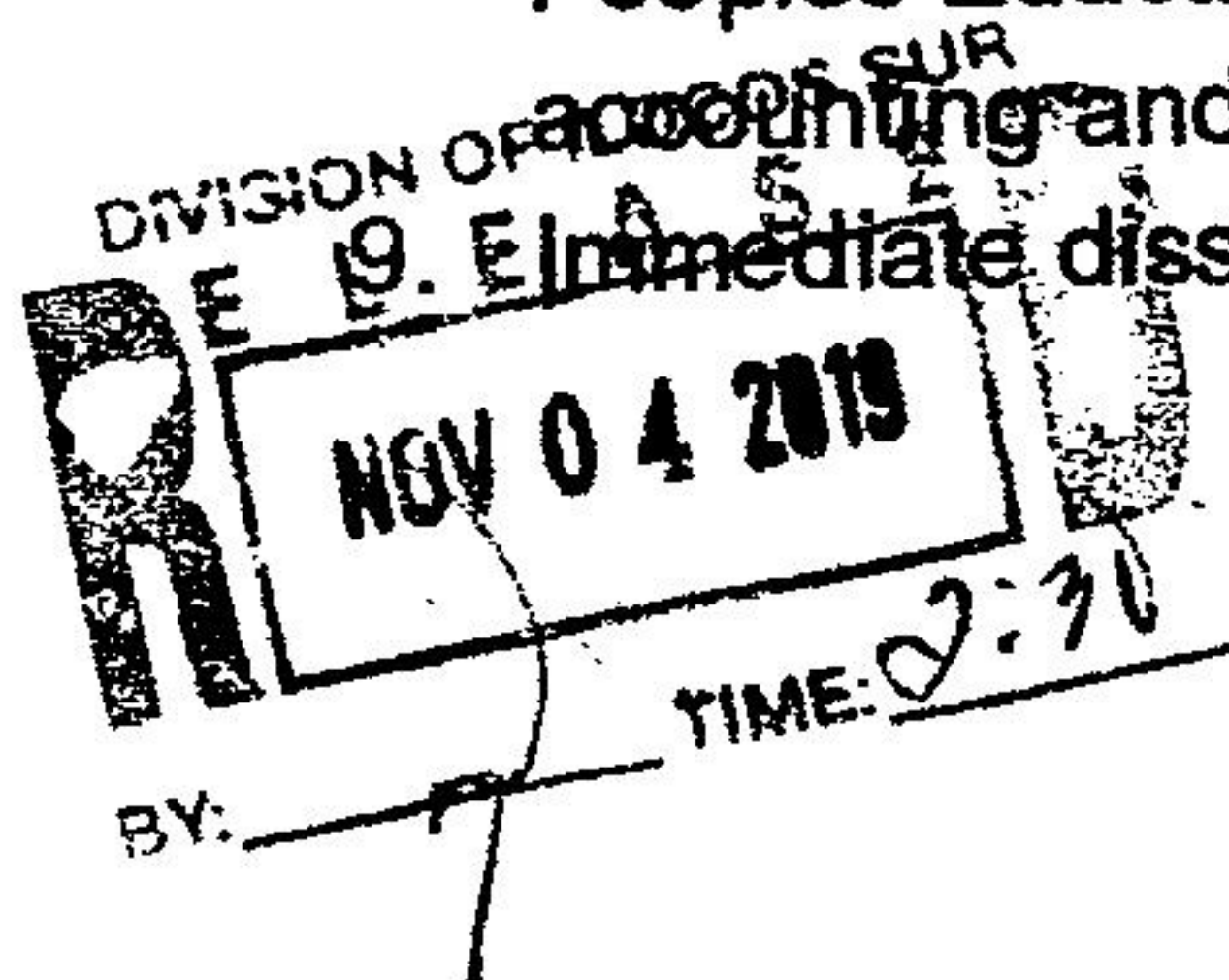

**2019 DIVISION CELEBRATION OF INDIGENOUS PEOPLES EDUCATION (IPED)**

**To: Chief Education Supervisor  
Education Program Supervisors  
Public Schools District Supervisors  
Principals of Public Elementary & Secondary IPED Implementing Schools**

1. The Schools Division of Ilocos Sur will conduct the 2019 Division Celebration of Indigenous Peoples' Education (IPED) on November 12, 2019 at Quirino National High School, Poblacion, Quirino, Ilocos Sur with the theme **"Karunungan ng Katutubong Pamayanan Paigtingin: Pundasyon ng Katutubong Edukasyon"**
2. The activity aims to promote greater awareness and appreciation of the Indigenous Peoples Cultural heritage and history.
3. The participants to the said celebration are the contestants, coaches, school heads, Public Schools District Supervisors, Education Supervisors and Chief Education Supervisor. Two (2) elders from each tribe and 12 IP elders from Quirino District shall be invited to attend.
4. Administrative remedy shall be undertaken to the classes left behind by the teacher participants/coaches while parent's permit shall be secured by the pupil participants.
5. The head of the district/school delegation coming from far places is advised to coordinate closely with the host Principal of Quirino National High School (09183956047) & Quirino Central School (09499524833) for their accommodation.
6. The followings shall be undertaken:
  - a. Socialization/IP Night of November 11, 2019, which the host district shall prepare for the participants arriving early.
  - b. Contested Activites:
    1. IP Teachers Got Talent – one teacher participant per district will compete in that contest. Performance should be an **IP Talent** and does not exceed 3 minutes.
    2. Pakpakaok – three contestants from Grade 1 or 2 shall compete in this game. (See attached guidelines).
    3. Kadang-kadang –  
Male category - one contestant from Grade 3 level. (See attached guidelines)  
Female category – one contestant from Grade 3 level (see attached guidelines)
    4. Sanggol – one contestant from Grade 4 (see attached guidelines).
    5. Buwabo – two male contestants from Grade 5 or Grade 6 per district will compete. (guidelines will be set by facilitators)
7. Participants and Contestants are encouraged to wear their Indigenous Costumes.
8. Travel expenses of participants in attending the 2019 Division celebration of Indigenous Peoples Education shall be charged against the school MOOE/local funds subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is enjoined.

**Guidelines in Playing Pakpakaok**

1. There should be 3 female participants from Grade 1 or Grade 2 per district.
2. Players should be barefooted.
3. Contestants together with the facilitators shall be chanting repeatedly the Pakpakaok phrase "**Pakpakaok, adikan maok-okaot**" while the contestants shall lock their right foot together while dancing and hopping with the rhythm.
4. If contestant's feet will be unlocked they are automatically out.
5. Last 3 set of contestants to be unlocked shall be announced as winners.

**Guidelines in playing Kadang-kadang**

1. There should only be 1 male and 1 female participant per district from Grade 3 level.
2. The kadang-kadang to be used will be provided by the management.
3. Players should be barefooted.
4. If the player accidentally fell down on his way to the finish line, he/she has to go back to the starting point and repeat the performance and finish the same.
5. There shall be elimination round depending on the number of participants.
6. The first 3 in each category to reach the finish line shall be the winners.

**Guidelines in playing Sanggol/Arm Wrestling**

1. There should be 1 male contestant from Grade 4 in each district.
2. Contestant shall be sitting or standing on the same position.
3. Contestants will start forcing when the signal "go" is given.
4. Elimination round will be given depending on the numbers of participants.
5. Facilitators shall act as judges and at the same to declare the winners.
6. The contestant who will touch the table first will be the loser.

**Guidelines in the IP Teachers Got Talent**

1. There should only be 1 participant per district and secondary school.
2. Performance should be an IP Talent such as chants, IP songs, playing IP instruments and the like.
3. Performance should not exceed 3 minutes.
