**DIVISION TRAINING ON THE USE OF GRAPHING CALCULATOR FOR
SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL TEACHERS**

1. The Schools Division of Ilocos Sur shall conduct a 3-day Training on the use of Graphing Calculator for Senior High School math teachers on December 3-5, 2019 at the Bantay West Central School Conference Hall, Bantay, Ilocos Sur.
2. The objectives of this training are:
 - ❖ To capacitate senior high school math teachers on the use of Graphing Calculators in teaching General Mathematics, Statistics and Probability, Business Mathematics, Pre-calculus and Basic Calculus.
 - ❖ To enhance the teaching-learning process on the said subjects.
 - ❖ To ensure the maximum and safe utilization of the Graphing Calculators distributed by the Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR).
3. The participants to this training are the eighty 80 senior high school mathematics teachers of the division. Newly established senior high school shall send a teacher-participant. (Please see attached list).
4. Expenses on meals and snacks shall be charged against **Provincial SEF - Mathematics** funds. Travel Expenses of participants and their incidental expenses shall be charged against local school funds (MOOE) subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
5. District Supervisors, Principals, Administrators and School Heads are requested to extend their full support and cooperation to ensure a successful conduct of this activity.
6. **Participants to this training are required to bring all the scientific calculators distributed by the Bureau of Learning Resources (BLR).**
