- 1.  - 3.3. Gather public support for the campaign using advocacy materials.
- 4. Venue rental, meals and snacks of participants including supplies and materials of the said activity shall be charged against Gender and Development (GAD) Funds of the Division subject to the usual budgeting/accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Schools shall also organize and conduct similar activities as those suggested by the PCW to meet the objectives of the said campaign. The school GAD Focal Point System shall spearhead the conduct and complete documentation of their respective activities.


